

Christian Men's Conference Set for Mid-Atlantic Region Saturday, March 23, 2013

WASH., DC – Dr. Tony Evans, one of the best known pastors and most sought after speakers in the nation, will be the featured keynoter at New Antioch Baptist Church in Randallstown MD Saturday, March 23, 2013 for an "*Iron Sharpens Iron*" Men's Conference. It will be the largest men's gathering in the mid-Atlantic region this year.

Former National Football League quarterback Jeff Kemp and Vice President of Family Life will join Evans to headline the day-long conference. The conference will also feature eighteen different seminars led by pastors, prominent men's leaders and teachers on topics relevant to interests and needs of men of all ages and stages of life. Worship will be led by "The Iron Man Praise Band". Dozens of ministry exhibitors will also help resource and equip men for ministry and life.

Dr. Tony Evans has served as the senior pastor of Oak Cliff Bible Fellowship in Dallas TX for 35 years and is president of The Alternative, a national ministry that seeks to bring about spiritual renewal in America through the church. His daily radio broadcast can be heard on more than 500 radio stations and in more than 40 countries. Dr. Evans latest bestselling book is *Kingdom Man*.

Jeff Kemp played eleven seasons for the Los Angeles Rams, San Francisco 49ers, Seattle Seahawks, and the Philadelphia Eagles. He and his late father, Jack Kemp, are one of only five sets of fathers and sons who have played quarterback in the NFL. Jeff was the founder of *Stronger Families* and serves on the steering committee for the *Marriage CoMission*. He is currently Vice President of Family Life ministry headquartered in Little Rock AR

"Iron Sharpens Iron is the premiere men's event in the Mid-Atlantic region.
